### **Kindergarten**

- SUPPLY BOX- (Put all supplies in a labeled box)

### **1<sup>st</sup> Grade**

- 1 big rubber eraser
- 1 pencil case- must be soft, no plastic boxes please
- 2 packages of post-its
- 1 package of index cards (3x5)
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 box of crayons
- 1 child scissor

### **2<sup>nd</sup> Grade**

- 2 packs of #2 sharpened pencils
- 1 big rubber eraser
- 1 pencil case- must be soft, no plastic boxes please
- 2 packages of post-its
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 box of crayons
- 1 child scissor

### **3<sup>rd</sup> Grade**

- 5 marble composition notebooks
- 5 2-pocket folders
- 2 packs of pencils
- Colored pencils – 12 pack
- Markers – 8 pack
- Crayons – 24 pack
- 2-3 Glue sticks
- Erasers

### **4<sup>th</sup> Grade**

- Pencils with Erasers (#2 pencils)
- Pens (Black or Blue)
- 1 Hand-Held Pencil Sharpener (with lid)
- 1 1-inch Loose Leaf Binder
- USB (*optional*)
- Crayola Colored Pencils
- Crayola Crayons (24 pack)
- Scissors
- 2 Elmer's Glue Sticks
- 2 packs 3x3 yellow post-it notes
- 6 Marble notebooks

### **5<sup>th</sup> Grade**
